Filo Biased Scarf

A Gauge Exclusive

Materials needed

- Filo by Lang, 1 ball each in colors A, B, C
A: 899.0010 Navy
B: 899.0023 Lt. Grey
C: 899.0017 Green
- Size US 5 (3.75 mm) needle
- Finished dimensions: approx. 9" wide by 64"
- Gauge: 5.5 st/in

Abbreviations

- kfb – knit into the front and back of a stitch, increases 1
- k2tog – knit 2 stitches together
- rs – right side
- ws – wrong side
- yo – yarn over



Setup: With A, cast on 65 stitches and knit 2 rows

With B, start striping and establish RS row and bias as follows:

Row 1 (RS): K1, kfb, knit across row to last 3 stitches, k2tog, k1

Row 2 (WS): Knit all stitches

Alternate these 2 rows, striping A and B until work measures 5"

Begin Mesh pattern with color C:

Row 1 (RS): K1, kfb, (yo, k2tog) across the row to the last 3 stitches, then K2tog, k1

Row 2 (WS): Knit all stitches

Work mesh pattern until mesh measures 5", ending with a WS row.

Repeat striping /bias rows until you almost run out of yarn, leaving enough of color A to work 2 rows plus a bind-off at the end.
